Work will include site assessment, system design, procurement, installation, interconnection with the local utility, and commissioning. Any unforeseen site conditions or additional work not included in this proposal will be addressed via change orders.

## Warranties and Representations:

Installer warrants that the System will be free from defects in workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of commissioning. Manufacturer warranties for equipment shall be passed through to the Customer and are in addition to Installer's workmanship warranty. Customer acknowledges that power output and savings cannot be guaranteed and

may vary due to environmental factors.

**Permitting and Interconnection:**

Installer will obtain all necessary permits and approvals from relevant authorities having jurisdiction. Installer will assist Customer with utility interconnection application and process. Customer agrees to cooperate and provide timely access and information required for permits and interconnection.

**Site Access and Customer Responsibilities:**

Customer shall provide Installer reasonable access to the project site during normal business hours and shall ensure that the site meets all safety and accessibility requirements. Customer agrees to remove or notify Installer of any hazards or obstructions that might impede installation. Customer is responsible for any additional costs arising from unsafe or inaccessible conditions.

**Limitation of Liability:**

Installer's liability under this Agreement shall be limited to direct damages and shall not exceed the total amount paid by Customer hereunder. Installer shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, consequential, punitive, or special damages, including loss of profits or revenue, arising out of or related to the performance or non-performance of the System.

**Force Majeure:**

Neither party shall be liable for any delay or failure to perform caused by events beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, war, terrorism, labor disputes, or governmental actions. Time for performance shall be extended accordingly.

**Governing Law and Dispute Resolution:**

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of \_\_\_\_\_, without regard to its conflicts of laws principles.
